

Note by the Editor.

In general, no written papers were submitted by the speakers and in compiling and editing these minutes only notes and tape recordings, taken during the conference, were available. Because of the desire to have this report available in finished form in a short time, it was not possible to check the written presentation with the speakers. Therefore, the editor takes responsibility for imperfections, other than those inherent in the contributions.

In editing, the oral versions were adjusted somewhat in order to obtain a coherent set of minutes and to suit the written form. This was done without affecting factual content. Greater liberties were taken in editing the discussions, where it was necessary occasionally to change or omit question or answer for the sake of clarity and brevity.
