

Recollection of Dieter Moehl

In 1977, we three started the construction of ion storage ring TARN at the Institute of Nuclear Study Univ. of Tokyo in view of the future heavy ion acclerator facility, NUMATRON in Japan.

In 1979, Takeshi and Akira joined in the Heavy Ion Fusion Workshop at Berkeley where we met Dieter first time and worked together on the beam instabilities of high dense low energy, 50 MeV/u ion beam in the storage ring.

After the completion of RF stacking and stochastic cooling at TARN, Noboru stayed at CERN LEAR group in 1986~1987 to work on the stochastic cooling of low energy 60 MeV/c antiproton beam.

Dieter took Noboru and Takeshi hiking (Jura) and skiing (Zermatt).



At the same period Takeshi also worked together at LEAR group. Dieter Moehl, Michel Chanel and Piere Lefevre were main collaborators. Noboru consulted with Dieter on his job. Dieter's comment was pertinent and sometimes severe.

Noboru's memory: "The staying at CERN LEAR group for 19 monthes was one of my happiest periods in my life. I have ever met few persons so gentle, modest and wise as Dieter."

Akira moved to Kyoto University and started the construction of storage ring, S-LRS where he many times consulted and discussed with Dieter on the Laser Cooling.











Two greats enjoyning the Takeshi hand made Japanese noodle strings. (2003)
