SPMS Development

- Need to distribute the development of the SPMS
 - SPMS Core
 - SPMS Registration
 - SPMS Hotel Handling
 - Better support (time to dedicate to the SPMS)
- Need for ticketing system (users/developers)
- Need for versioning control (developers/developers)

Enter SourceForge.net

- Open web facility for Open Source projects
- It's open, it's free
- Plenty of tools
 - File repository for code distribution
 - Ticketing system for bug tracking
 - Concurrent Versioning Support systems

SPMS sorceforge project

- We'll use it for:
 - Ticketing
 - Code management
 - SPMS distribution

- Artifacts will be assigned to developers
- Email notifications
- History always available

Who can submit

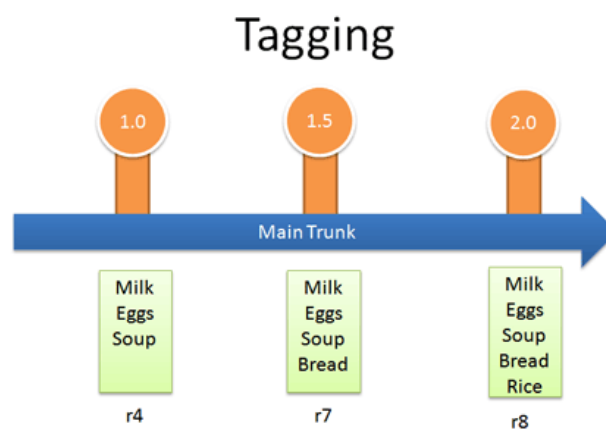
- Anyone that has a SourceForge account
- Creating a SF.net account is free and quick
- Developers have full power managing the artifacts
- Feature requests managed this way as well

Code management

- SF.net will host the SPMS code for development
- Stable versions will be distributed in the "Files" section
- a Concurrent Versioning Control System will be used for
 - SPMS core
 - SPMS modules
 - Upload/Download scripts
 - JPSP scripts

What can Versioning Control Systems do?

Help managing all the phases of code development

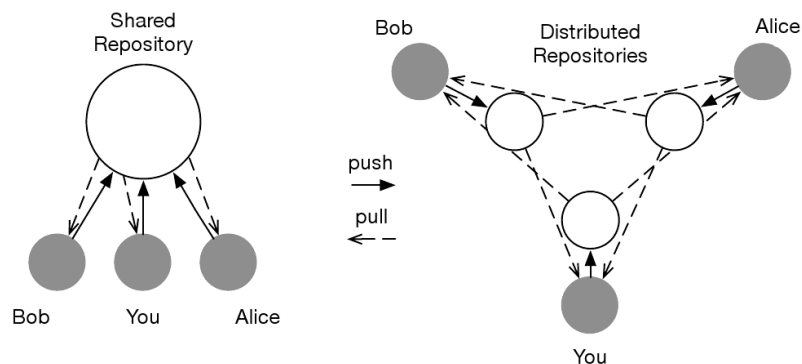


Versioning Control Systems

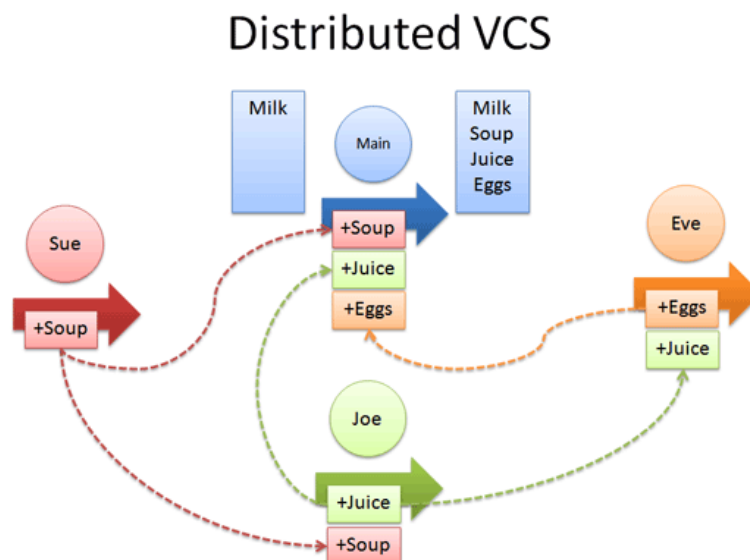
- Once upon a time there were...
 - RCS
 - CVS
- Then came SVN...
- ...and then GIT, Mercurial, ...
- We'll use GIT for the SPMS

Why GIT?

- It's a DISTRIBUTED VCS
- It's fast
- Works well off-line
- Easier branching and merging



DVCS differences

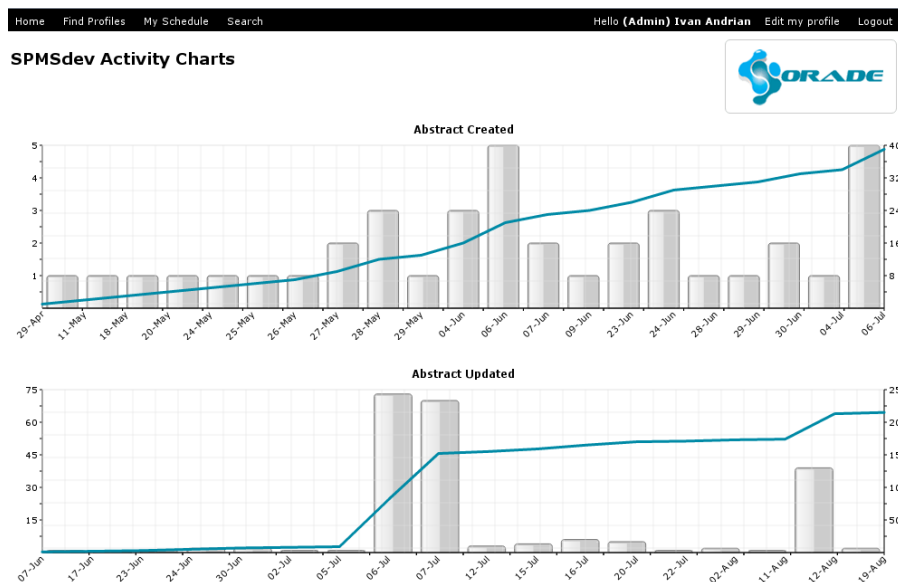


Current development at Elettra

 - Bug fixing

 - Navigation menus
 - HTML templates and themes

JACoW pre-Team Meeting 2010 summary

Repatriation

- Process to get some valuable data back from conference instances to repository
 - History of past conferences
 - Statistics
 - Future conference management (SPC...)
- Procedure not really followed
- We need to explicitly encourage repatriation
- Better documentation for editors

Contribution proposer

- Oral proposed by SPC
- "Template" contributions are created by the SPC
- Authors then will inherit this contributions
- Need better explicit handling of this "role"

Hot topics

- Default settings for new instances are not "ideal" or consistent
 - After conferences, update those settings in the repository
- Need for procedure for new feature requests and development
 - SourceForge will help but still human will and agreement is necessary
- What to do with conference instances after publication?
 - Truncate some data?
 - Keep DADs for future reference?
 - Extract INSPIRE information!
 - Archive DB?

INDICO

- Need for a **repository integration** (profiles)
- Need development
 - New INDICO authentication module against JACoW repository
 - Protect access of JACoW conferences at "event level"
 - ... we don't want anybody to authenticate against CERN SSO and then apply for JACoW events
- Do **not** have a "local copy" of the profiles
 - Cache only (some) data of registered people (main authors, presenters, ...)
 - Co-authors data will not be cached

INDICO

- Profiles are only copied initially, NOT synchronised
- e-mailing from JACoW-based INDICO instances won't be possible
 - The repository administrator will back up
- Need for a formal agreement by Conference Chairs
 - Not to abuse of the cached profiles data and repository access
 - as now for SPMS-based conferences
- Expect good news in the coming months!

INSPIRES - development areas

- Metadata level
 - XML file not always published on JACoW site
 - Enforce this procedure
 - Add report number in TeX bibliography format
- Profiles level
 - Better association of authors would be nice
 - Add ability to query the JACoW repository for authors-paper pairs from INSPIRE
 - Add person ID to the XML export for INSPIRE purposes
 - In the SPMS profile page link to INSPIRE author/papers search
- Technical level
 - INSPIRE developed "technical toys" that could be used by JACoW (Plot extractor, ...)
