

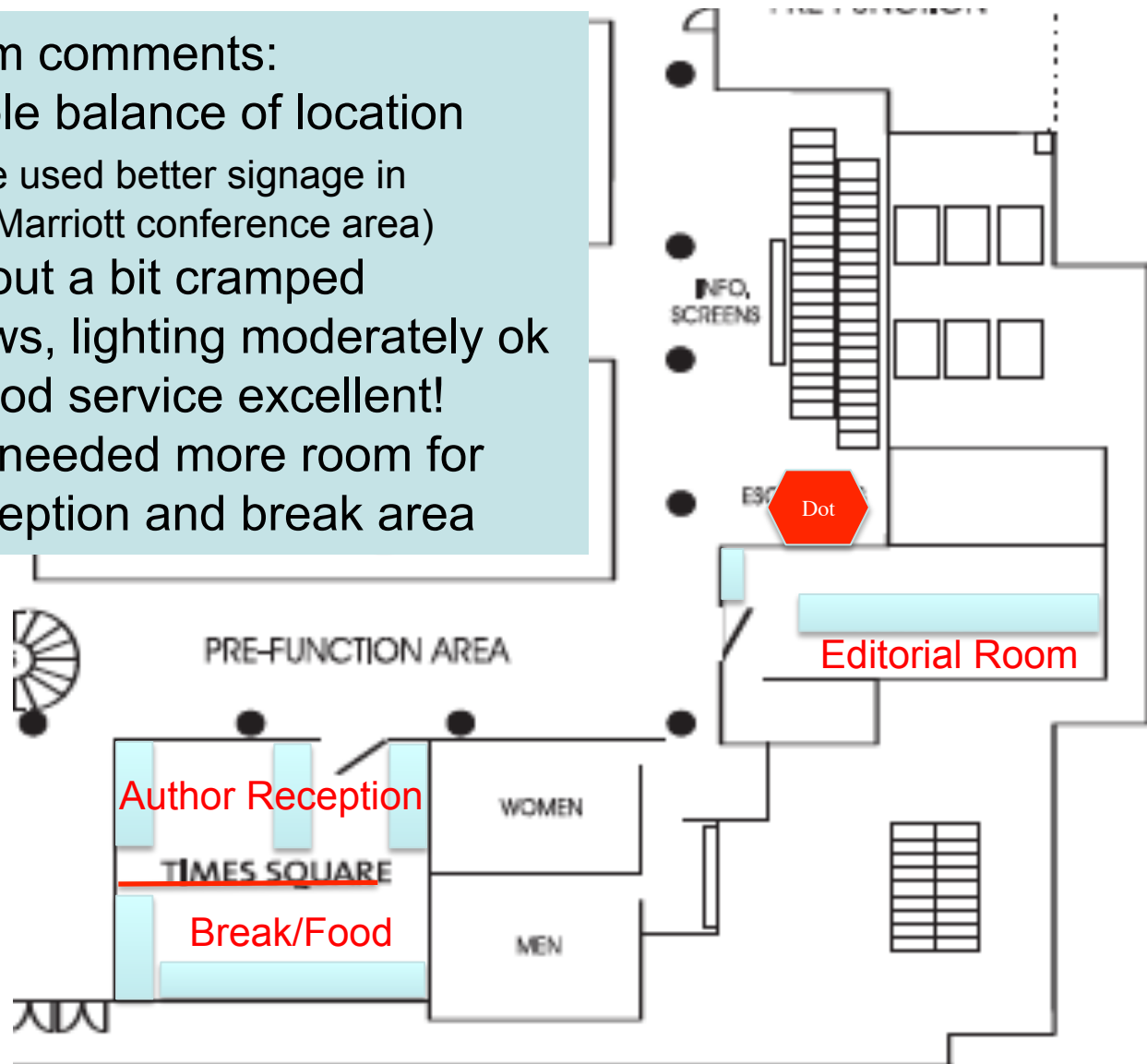

# Editor's Notes

- Final proceedings delivered to JACoW 5 Oct 2011
  - Six months after conference, quite a bit later than desired!
- Too much time spent chasing down and editing late papers
  - Set deadlines and keep to them
  - Avoid temptation to be pedantic about every figure caption
  - Chasing down missing IEEE forms also was part of delay
- Many thanks to Volker for several iterations of processing
- Team balance just about right for processing time available
  - 14 paper editors, 2 oral contribution editors on editorial team
  - Pre-conference processing location/setup not ideal but worked speedily thanks to great team composition
  - Pre-proceedings posted at end of conference with most papers



## Editors Notes II

- An unusually high number of withdrawn abstracts (380)
  - Likely due to conflicts, audience overlap with IPAC'11
- Tutorial sessions VERY well attended and received
  - Even 300+ at 08:00 tutorial Fri morning after the banquet!
- Moving upload server to venue was neither loss nor win
  - Complicated network setup not clearly understood by vendor
- Network issues at venue were severe at times
  - Even after considerable network checkout pre-conference
- For future NA-PAC/IEEE IPAC
  - IEEE willing to accept scanned pdf signed copyright forms
  - Perhaps have participants upload these with their paper source files at future conferences to minimize author reception overhead
