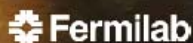

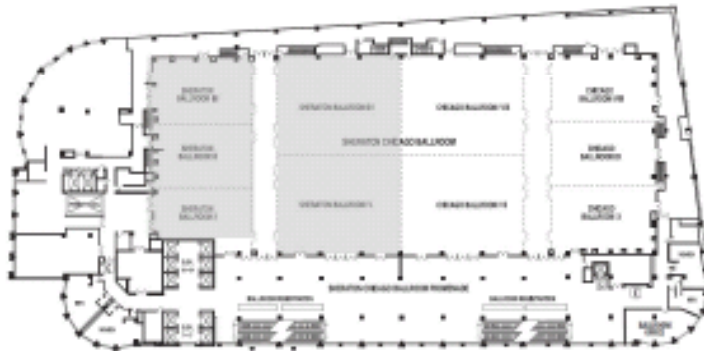

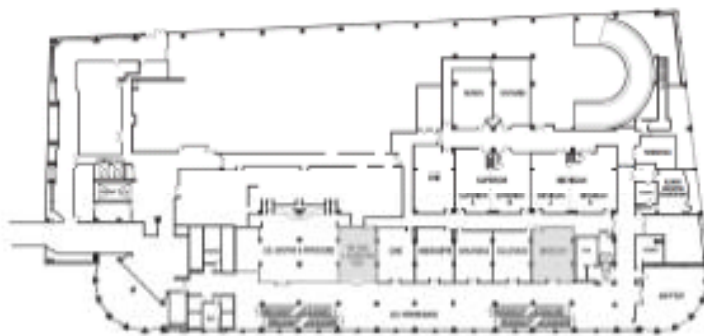


SHERATON FLOOR PLANS

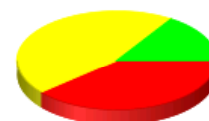
