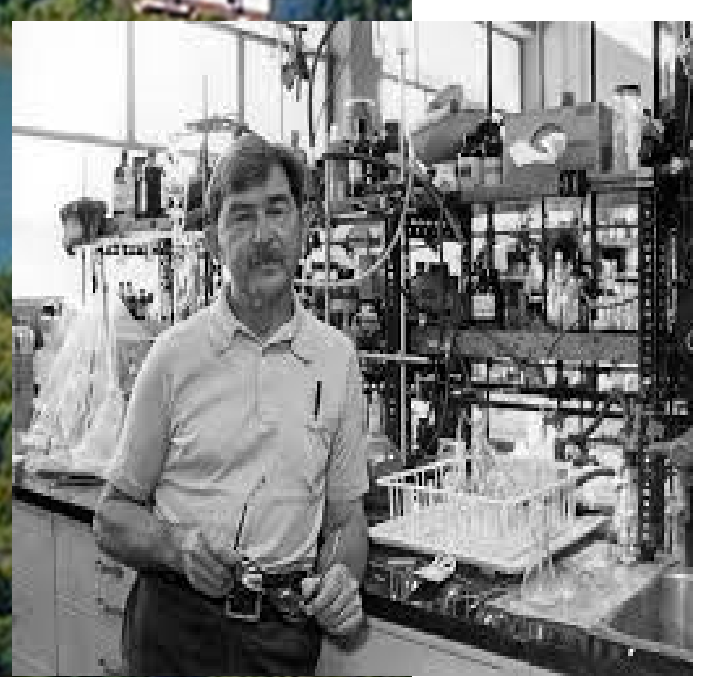
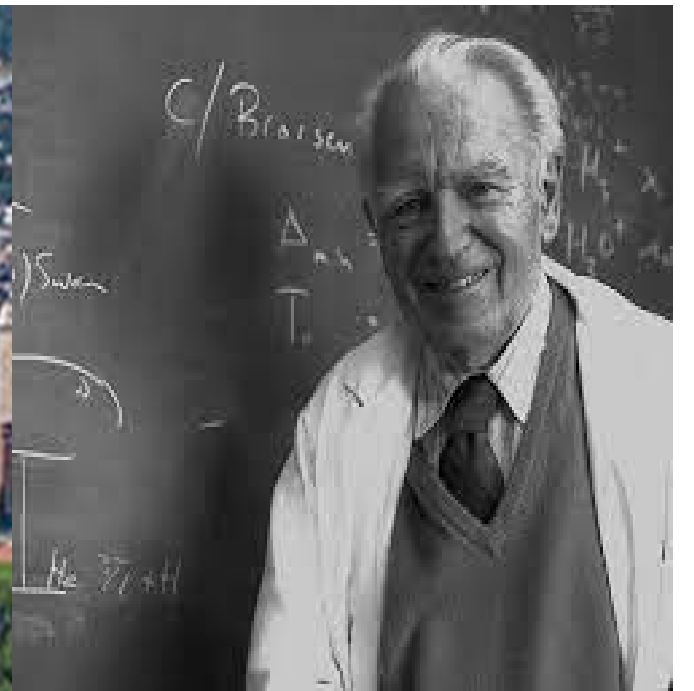


Experimental Hall
